Dress Code Reminder

As summer approaches please abide by the dress code policy of the Walton County School District.

For both male and female students, appropriate and acceptable dress include:

- All visible garment (layered garments) must be in accordance with the dress code

The following clothing items are not permitted at Freeport Elementary:

- Holes in garments above the knee
- Heelies, shoes with cleats, high heels or platform shoes greater than one inch, or bedroom shoes

- Garments containing a message that is obscene
