

Picture This!

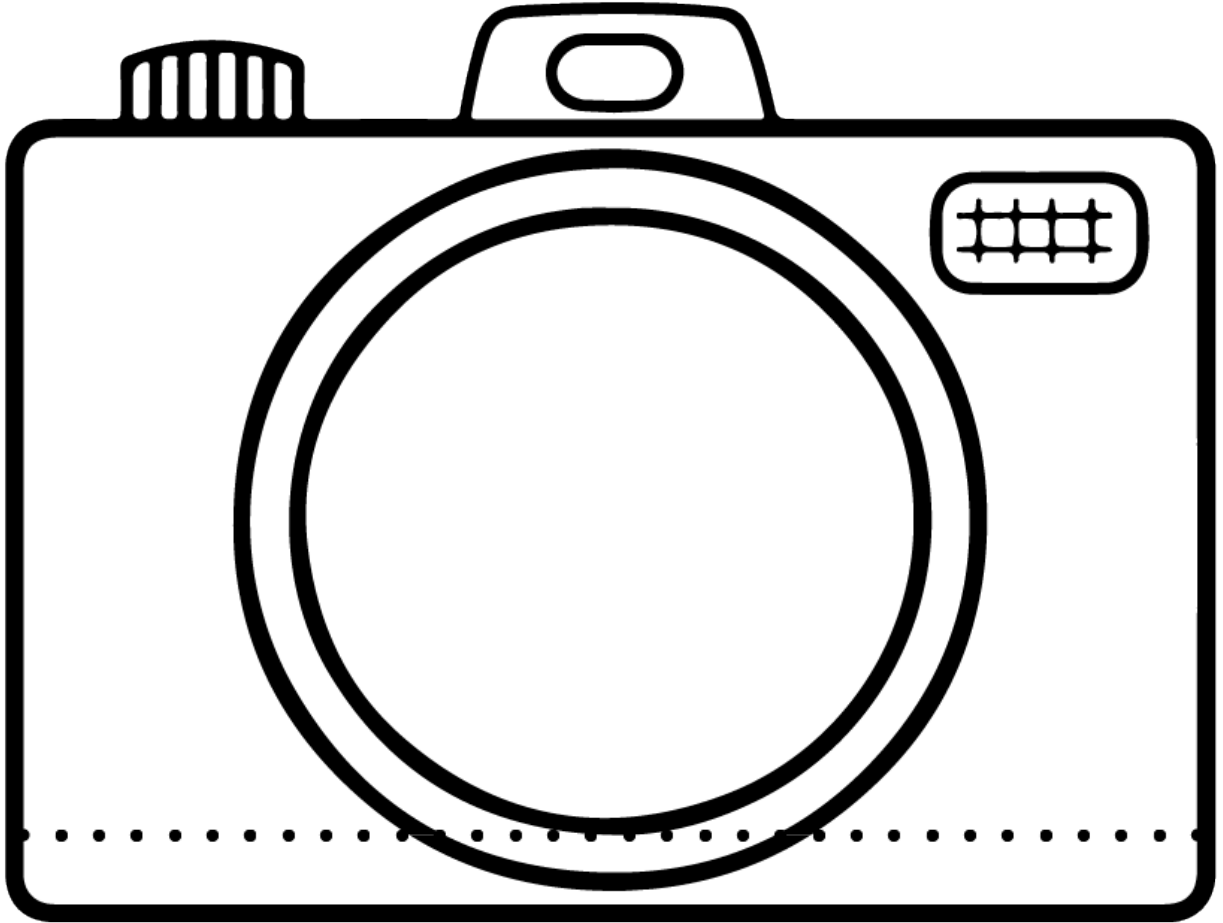
Students do a short goal setting activity with this fun template. First, have students write a goal or statement for the future. It can be for the summer, next school year or their adult lives. Using the camera template on the next page, they will write their goal or statement about their future on the lined part of the template. It is important they do not write below the dotted line. In the circle (lens) of the camera they will draw a picture of themselves meeting the goal. They can decorate the rest of the camera however they choose. Assemble the template by cutting out the two separate pieces and gluing or stapling the camera piece along the bottom fold to the lined piece along its bottom fold.



Ninja Note: We assembled all of our cameras on a bulletin board and titled it "Flash Forward." We asked students to only put their names on the back of their projects so other students could try to guess which student belonged to the future goal.

Student instructions: Write your goal or statement on the lines above the dotted line. Draw your picture in the circle on the camera. Cut out the shapes. Attach the pieces below the dotted line by gluing along the edge. Decorate your camera.
